

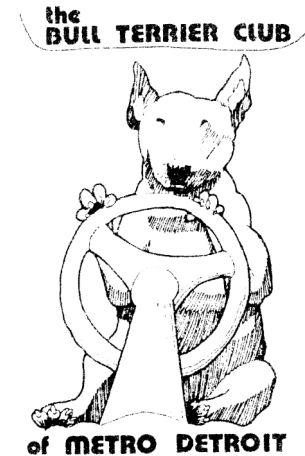

## SHOW REGULATIONS

The show site will be accessible at 7:00 AM, on Saturday, October 2, 2021.

A recording fee of 50 cents will be required for each dog entered at any license or Member Club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 14, Section 2).

Entry fees are \$30.00 for regular classes., \$25.00 for Puppy and Veterans, Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes. These fees include a \$3.00 event fee and a 50 cent American Kennel Club recording fee. Sweepstakes entry fee is \$15.00.

Dogs entered in the American Bred Classes must have been whelped in the United States by reason of a mating which took place in the United States (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 6, Section 8).

Foreign dogs (dogs not whelped in the USA or Canada) are eligible for Puppy and Open Classes effective, January 1, 1985.

Make all checks and money orders payable in U.S. funds to Dog Show In A Box. Checks or money orders must be sent with entries.

Telephone, Telegraph, fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not accepted.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Dog Show In A Box will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such error or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge or because of riots, civil disturbances or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.

The show giving Club, or their members, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

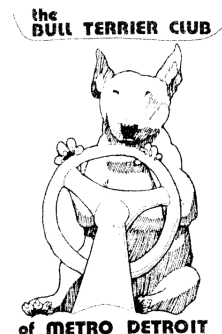

### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

**Veteran Dog & Bitch Class** – For dogs & bitches 7 years and older. Spayed bitches and neutered dogs are eligible to compete in the Veteran classes at this show.

### **NON REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

**STUD DOG CLASS**—FOR Stud Dogs and two or more of their get. Stud Dog must be entered in the class and shown in the ring with the Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Variety, or some other non-regular class.

**BROOD BITCH CLASS**— Same as for for Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

### **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

**BEST IN THE PUPPY CLASSES**— After the judging of Best of Variety in each variety, the first place winners of the 6-9 and 9-12 month Puppy Dog and Puppy Bitch classes will compete for Best in the Puppy Classes in Variety. After the judging of Best of Breed Competition, the Best in the Puppy Classes in each Variety will compete for Best in the Puppy Classes in Breed.

**BEST IN THE VETERANS CLASSES**— After the judging of Best of Breed the first place winners of each Veterans class in both varieties will compete for Best in the Veterans Classes in Breed.

**BEST MOVING BULL TERRIER**—After the judging of Best of Breed, and Best in the Puppy Classes in Breed, Winners and Reserve Winners in both varieties and all champions of Record entered in Best of Variety Competition may compete for Best Moving Bull Terrier.

## AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by a professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. **Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.**

Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, households and current assistants\*\* to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in this competition.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed/Variety competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of non-regular classes.

- If Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety and be eligible to compete in both the regular as well as the Owner-Handled Best of Breed competition
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is not eligible for Owner-Handled competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If neither the Best of Breed/Variety nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are Owner-Handled competition eligible and Select Dog & Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all Champions and non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If the regular show Best of Breed/Variety, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety, Select Dog & Select Bitch are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed/Variety including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Best of Breed/Variety for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series.
- If the Best of Winners is eligible, the other Winners are ineligible since it was defeated.
- No class dogs other than Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are eligible to return to the ring.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Best of Breed Competition if there is no eligible dogs competing in the Best of Breed/Variety or in Best of Winners competition.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.

\*\* A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.

**NOTE: NOHS points are awarded through Best of Variety at this show, the AKC does not award additional NOHS points for Best of Breed Wins at specialties for breeds with varieties.**
