The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. The winners of these classes will compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF BREED

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If at the end of the 90 day period, and the championship of the dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by the AKC.

AWARDS OF MERIT

The judge may, at their discretion, recall into the ring up to 10% of Best of Breed entries to receive Rosettes offered by the Dalmatian Club of Southern California. These Rosettes are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

Non-Regular Classes, Involving Multiple Dog Entries:

Stud Dog Class / Brood Bitch Class - Stud Dog/Brood Bitch and two, of his /her Get/ Produce. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class and shown in the ring with Get/ Produce. The owner of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not own Get/Produce. Get/Produce will be judged on own merit. While the merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if he/she has a condition that would require him/her to be disqualified or to be excused under Dog Show Rules, American Kennel Club policy, or the standard for his/her breed. Get or Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch. Therefore, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class."

Parade of Champions & Title Holders: Any Dalmatian holding an American Kennel Club Title of Record in Breed, Obedience, or Rally is eligible to participate in the Title Parade. Dogs so entered will be presented a Rosette with the dogs name printed on it in Gold Leaf.

10 Years and Over

The puppy sweepstakes will be open to all Dalmatians, who on the day of the show will be six months and under 18 months of age. Each dog must also enter a regular class. Entries are to be made at the same time and on the same form as the entries for the regular classes. Sweepstakes classes should be indicated in the area marked "additional classes" on the entry form.

Professional Handlers may show only dogs they own.

Veteran dog/bitch need not be entered in any other class at this show. Veterans competing in Sweepstakes may be spayed or neutered. Professional Handlers may show only dogs they own.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES— DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY

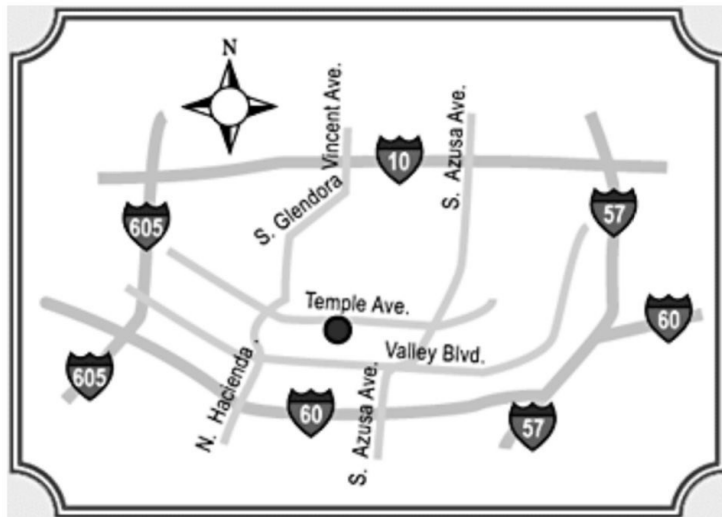
FROM BURBANK

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice class. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED: **Junior**-9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show; **Intermediate**-12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show; **Senior**-15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919)233- 9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

SHOW REGULATIONS

The show site will be accessible at 7:00 AM.

A recording fee of 50 cents will be required for each dog entered at any license or Member Club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 14, Section 2).

Entry fees are \$30.00 for regular classes., \$25.00 for Puppy Classes, 6-9 Months and 9-12 Months. No charge for Junior Showmanship. \$10.00 for Parade of Champions & Titleholders. These fees include a \$3.00 event fee and a 50 cent American Kennel Club recording fee. Sweepstakes entry fee is \$20.00.

Dogs entered in the American Bred Classes must have been whelped in the United States by reason of a mating which took place in the United States (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 6, Section 8).

Foreign dogs (dogs not whelped in the USA or Canada) are eligible for Puppy and Open Classes effective, January 1, 1985.

Make all checks and money orders payable in U.S. funds to DOG SHOW IN A BOX Checks or money orders must be sent with entries.

Telephone, Telegraph, fax and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not accepted.

Return checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee of \$35.00 to the amount of each returned check.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such error or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge or because of riots, civil disturbances or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
