Telephone and Unsigned Entries cannot be accepted. Entries on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry form without agreement on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgment not be received within a reasonable time, please contact Dog Show in a Box.

Make all checks payable to Dog Show in a Box. Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds. Please mail check or money orders with entries. The Dog Show in a Box assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

Closing date for entries is 6:00 P.M. CDT, September 8, 2021, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed “Except as provided for in Chapter 15, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.”

AKC Event Service Fees and recording fees will be required for the first and additional entry of each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking test. The fees are to be collected by the trial giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2). The event service fees and recording fees are included in the entry fee.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Post-Dated and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The show-giving Club will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No Refund for duplicate entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however if an entry has been processed no refund will be made.

Errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the published closing date.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

The MBTCA reserves the right to photograph this event and to assign these rights exclusively to **the show photographer** as the sole producer of photography from this event that may be offered for commercial sale.

trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I(we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes. 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth),

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

The following classes are offered in each sex:

Puppy: 6 Months & Under 9 Months

Puppy: 9 Months & Under 12 Months

Senior: 12 Months & Under 18 Months

The sweepstakes will be open to all Miniature Bull Terriers, who on the day of the show will be at least 6 months and under 18 months of age. No dog that is a "CHAMPION OF RECORD" may compete. Each dog must be entered a regular class. Entries are to be made at the same time and on the same form as the entries for the regular classes. **Sweepstakes classes should be indicated in the area marked "additional classes" on the entry form.**

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Each veteran dog must be entered in a regular class or non regular class. **Sweepstakes classes should be indicated in the area marked "additional classes" on entry form.**

The following classes are offered in each sex:

Veteran: 7 Years & Under 9 Years

Veteran: 9 Years & Under 12 Years

Veteran: 12 Years & Older

Prize money for Puppy and Veteran Sweepstakes in each class will be based on a percentage of entry fees in that class divided as follows:

First Prize 30% Third Prize 10%

Second Prize 20% Fourth Prize 5%

35% Will be retained by Club for expenses.

STUD DOG/BROOD BITCH COMPETITION

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Classes – no less than two and no more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs/Brood Bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Get/Produce. Entry to be judged only based on the merits of the Get/Produce. While the merits of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its breed. Get/Produce MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed Competition in the National Specialty, October 3, 2021. Entry fee is \$35.00 if Stud Dog/Brood Bitch is NOT entered in the classes at the National Specialty. If shown in the classes at the National Specialty, the entry fee is \$15.00 as an additional class. Notation must be made on entry form.

A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

The breed will not be represented in the Owner-Handled Group if there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed, or in Best of Winners competition.

**Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers’ organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

(4-6 months of age) AKC Sanctioned Beginner Puppy Competition!

Section 1- Classifications

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility

Entry and eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.
- A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.*

Junior Showmanship

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS This class will be for Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.
